### THOMAS KERR, JR. GUEST SOLOIST

Thomas H. Kerr, Jr., Associate Professor of Piano at Howard University, will appear as guest soloist with the National Symphony Orchestra under the direction of Howard Mitchell at Cardozo High School Monday, March 30.
